

- A terminal power source (7-48 volts, 3 amps)
- A Phillips type screwdriver (optional for DIN mounting)

Mounting the USB hub


1. Attach the DIN rail clips to the USB hub, using the DIN rail screws (provided) and a Phillips type screwdriver (sold separately).



2. Slide the DIN rail clips into the DIN rail on your rack.

Installation

- 1. Connect the USB 2.0 host port (PORT 0) on the hub to a USB port on your computer, using the included USB-A to USB-B cable.
- 2. Connect your peripherals to the USB 2.0 ports on the USB hub.
- 3. Connect the positive and negative power pins on your power source cabling to the corresponding sockets on the power terminal, along with the grounding wire.
