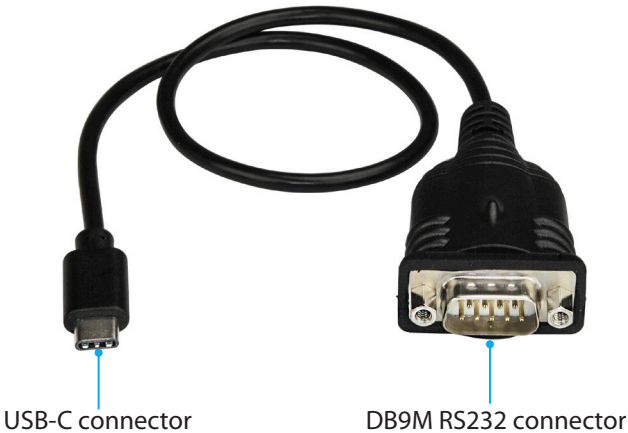

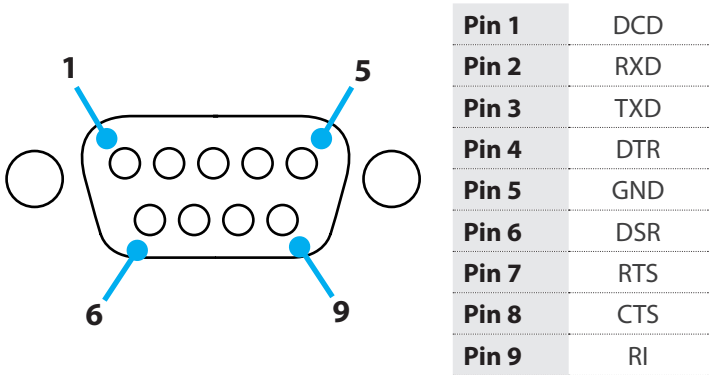

About COM retention

The USB to serial adapter features COM retention (also known as COM port retention). With COM retention, the COM port settings that are assigned the first time that the adapter is connected to a computer are retained, regardless of the USB port that the adapter cable is connected to. When you disconnect the serial adapter cable and plug it into a different USB port on the same computer, you don't need to reconfigure the serial port.

Install the adapter cable

Windows

1. In a web browser, navigate to [www.StarTech.com/ICUSB232PROC](http://www.StarTech.com/ICUSB232PROC).
2. Click the **Support** tab.
3. Under **Driver(s)**, download the [Prolific\_PL2303] Windows USB **Serial Adapter.zip** file.
4. Right-click the folder that you downloaded and click **Extract All**.
5. Right-click the **Setup.exe** file and click **Run as Administrator**.
6. Follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
7. When prompted, restart your computer.
8. Connect the serial adapter cable to a USB port.

1. In a web browser, navigate to [www.StarTech.com/ICUSB232PROC](http://www.StarTech.com/ICUSB232PROC).
2. Click the **Support** tab.
3. Under **Driver(s)**, download the [Prolific\_PL2303] Mac USB Serial Adapter.zip file.
4. Right-click the folder that you downloaded and click **Extract All**.
5. Double-click the **Mac** folder.
6. Double-click the folder for the version of macOS that you're running.
7. Run the installer application and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the installation.
8. When prompted, restart your computer.
9. Connect the serial adapter cable to a USB port.

## Verify the installation

### Windows

1. Navigate to **Device Manager**.
2. Expand the **Ports (COM&LPT)** section.
3. Confirm that **Prolific USB-to-Serial Comm Port (COMx)** appears in the list with no exclamation points or question marks.

### macOS

1. Navigate to the **System Profiler**.
2. Expand the **Hardware** section and click **USB**.
3. Confirm that **USB-Serial Controller D** appears in the list.
